2. Implementation of systems and risk management program

Our health, safety and environmental management system will be continually improved through a comprehensive health, safety and environmental risk management program. This is founded in our organisational values, principles of social responsibility, work safety and environmental protection, setting of objectives and measurable targets and effective processes that will ensure the highest standard of performance.

We will continue to maintain certification of our environmental management system to the international standard ISO14001. We will strictly observe all applicable statutory requirements, provide a safe and healthy working environment, ensure dissemination of HSE information and train our employees accordingly.
