### The New Bosch 32ltr Commercial Series

To join our already impressive range of domestic gas hot water heaters is the next generation of commercial hot water heating technology, the Bosch 32 series – KM3211WH and KM3211WHQ in LPG and NG.

Bosch has been supplying hot water to Australian families for nearly 50 years and forms part of the worldwide Thermotechnology division of Robert Bosch. Bosch is Europe's number one heating technology manufacturer for space and water heating.

Bosch has been at the forefront of the gas hot water heating industry and has pioneered many innovations such as HydroPower ignition, first wall hung gas hot water system and the first gas hot water system with battery ignition. All Bosch Gas Hot Water Systems are manufactured to the highest possible standards using only premium quality materials. We are constantly improving our design, engineering and manufacturing processes to ensure our customers only receive state of the art hot water systems. The Bosch promise of quality is the corner stone of our business.

The 32ltr commercial units are specifically designed for Australian and New Zealand commercial use. Options include one unit through to a full manifold system. The Bosch commercial units have all your applications covered. The 32 series has a coated copper heat exchanger to prevent corrosion and deterioration and the internal copper piping is 25% thicker than residential models to extend the life of the product. In addition, the Quick Connect Cord (KMQC0703339) is available for easy installation of 2 units manifolded for heavier applications.

The Bosch 32 and 32Q will, after a power outage (with a controller attached), reactivate within one minute of the power coming back on. It will go back to the settings that it had before the loss of power, (perfect for commercial applications such as sporting complexes). Both the 32 and 32Q feature the same physical dimensions. Antifrost comes as a standard option with the 32 series.

The units can be installed either internally (using the Bosch flue kit), or externally with the additional Bosch accessory, Vent Cap (KMVC100), making the Bosch 32 series the most flexible units on the market.

The 32 series are most effective when coupled with the optional temperature controllers. The controllers offer fingertip water temperature control, accurate to single degrees. The commercial controller gives you the advantage of not having to mix hot water with cold water as this is done automatically inside the unit.

Bosch have also developed a range of Professional Packs ready to be shipped to your site for installation. The packs come with range of different sizes from a 250ltr tank + 200mj burner to a 315 litre tank +250mj burner.

Accessories include: Main Remote Controller (RCM3211), Sub Controller (RCS3211), Vent Cap (KMVC3211), Quick Connection Cable (KMQC0703339), System Controller (KMSC201), plus 3 or 5 metre cables for the system controller.
