1.1 Environmental Management Systems at Suppliers

As stipulated in the Bosch Quality Assurance Agreement (QSL1):

The Supplier commits himself to comply with all legal regulations regarding the environment, health and occupational safety, and to strive to avoid all negative effects on humans and the environment by an adequate organisation and realization of environmental protection in the company. For this, the implementation and further development of an Environmental Management System (EMS) according to ISO 14001 is expected. The Bosch Standard N 2580 "Prohibition and Declaration of Substances" is part of each delivery agreement.
